**Research Analysis**

HB 1047 directs the Department of Public Safety to promulgate rules and procedures whereby a person may apply for a renewal or replacement Oklahoma commercial driver license through a tag agency. Any a commercial driver license holder wanting to renew or replace a hazardous material endorsement is required to renew or replace in person at the Department.

**Fiscal Analysis**

HB 1047, as introduced, directs the Department of Public Safety to promulgate rules and procedures relating to renewal and replacement of Oklahoma commercial driver licenses.
