**Research Analysis**

HB 1063, as introduced, authorizes a board of county commissioners to employ information technology staff in addition to or in place of the currently-authorized data processing technician. The measure removes a requirement that the data processing technician's term may not extend beyond the term of office of the board appointing them.
