HB 1093, as introduced, directs the Oklahoma Water Resources Board to update its water quality standards to allow for development of watershed trading programs by November 1, 2026.

**Fiscal Analysis**

According to officials at the Oklahoma Water Resource Board, this bill requires additional rule making, which will require one additional Full Time Employee based on recent experience in creating rules for other programs. The costs of one FTE for OWRB in this position would be about \$90,000 including salary and benefits. Therefore, there would be an impact to the State's budget and appropriation of \$90,000 to fund the one FTE.
