Fiscal Analysis

HB 1112 gives the Oklahoma Department of Wildlife Conservation more control over setting certain hunting season dates and other rules. It does not appear to create a fiscal impact on the Department. Additionally, the Department is a nonappropriated agency. Therefore, it is unlikely HB 1112 in its current form should not create a fiscal impact on the State's budget or appropriations.
