HB 1120 allows a state agency, department, institution or satellite office that is subject to the Central Purchasing Act but is located in a county without contracted vendors to purchase necessary equipment and supplies from a local business without obtaining a waiver or permission. Each of these acquisitions must be documented, including justification for the purchase, supporting documents, copies of all contracts, and any other information required by the State Purchasing Director.
