HB 1122 caps the rate charged by a rural electric cooperative for attachments to their utility poles by communications services providers. The capped rate does not include charges for electric power. A rural electric cooperative that attaches to a pole, resulting in relocation of a communications provider's existing attachment, must pay for the cost of relocation of that attachment.
