**Unknown Minimal Increase in  
Motor Vehicle Collections**

**Research Analysis**

HB 1136 requires the Oklahoma Tax Commission to develop rules for the titling and registration of High Mobility Multipurpose Wheeled Vehicles which are commonly known as Humvees for operation on public roadways.

**Fiscal Analysis**

Analysis provided by the Tax Commission:

Section 1 of the measure proposes enactment of Section 1151.5 of Title 47 to require High Mobility Multipurpose Wheeled Vehicles (HMMWVs or Humvees as more commonly known) to be registered pursuant to the provisions of the Oklahoma Vehicle License and Registration Act. It also requires the Tax Commission to promulgate rules for the titling and registration of HMMWVs.

Section 2 of the measure proposes amendment to Section 1102 of Title 47 to define "High Mobility Multipurpose Wheeled Vehicle" or "HMMWV" as a four-wheel drive tactical military vehicle that can carry a wide variety of military hardware, more commonly known as a Humvee.

The federal titles for these vehicles are branded with the notation off-road use only. The current provisions of the Oklahoma Vehicle License and Registration Act provide that motor vehicle manufactured principally for use off the streets and highways shall not be registered under the provisions of the Act. 47 O.S. § 1151(E). Therefore, the mandated registration of these vehicles as proposed herein appears to be in conflict with existing statutory language.

The measure will result in an unknown minimal increase in motor vehicle revenues for FY 22 and FY 23.
