Fiscal Analysis

According to officials from Construction Industries Board anticipated software modification costs as a result of this measure range from \$10,000 to \$30,000. If the measure results in additional new licensees, it could help offset the costs. The Construction Industries Board is a non-appropriated state agency. HB 1150 in its current form is not expected to have a direct fiscal impact on the state budget or appropriation.
