Research Analysis

The committee substitute (CS) for HB 1246 allows for a social security number to be used to obtain prescriptions when a state-issued identification card has expired.

The CS declares an emergency.

Fiscal Analysis

The measure provides that when a prescription is written or dispensed to a person whose state-issued identification card has been expired for no more than one year and that person does not possess another form of authorized identification, a Social Security number may be used to comply with reporting requirements.

Upon review and with consultation from the Oklahoma Bureau of Narcotics and Dangerous Drugs Control, the measure is determined to have no anticipated direct impact on state revenues or expenditures.
