**Research Analysis**

The Senate amendment to HB1568 requires schools to include instruction in mental health as part of any health education curriculum. School districts may work with pre-approved non-profits to provide this education.

The State Board of Education must revise the academic standards for Health and Physical Education to include a focus on mental health and develop a list of age-appropriate resources for students in grades K-12.
