**Fiscal Analysis**

HB 1581 restricts where dogs and cats sold in Pet Stores can be supplied from. Upon reviewing this measure there is no state wide agency involved, meaning local entities will be tasked with enforcing the measure. Given the narrow scope of the bill and that enforcement will be spread across local entities rather than a state wide agency, there is no indication that HB 1581 will have an impact on the State's budget and appropriations.
