Research Analysis

The proposed committee substitute for HB1593 modifies how often teachers are required to take certain professional development trainings.

These trainings shall be completed the first year a teacher is employed by a district, then at a frequency determined by the local board:

- The importance of digital teaching and learning standards
- Incorporating workplace safety training into curriculum, for 7-12 grade teachers

These trainings shall be completed the first year a teacher is employed by a district, then every third year:

- Recognizing and addressing the mental health needs of students
- Substance abuse prevention and life skills
