HB 1606 the proposed committee substitute, establishes a procedure to be followed after arbitration decisions or awards have been made. Decisions and awards should be complied with and implemented within 30 days of the decision unless otherwise mutually agreed upon in writing by both parties. Failure to comply within the 30 day period will constitute a violation of paragraph 6, Unfair Labor Practices, of Section 51-102 of Title 11 of the Oklahoma Statutes. The non-complying party is subject to the penalties set forth in Section 51-113 of Title 11 of the Oklahoma Statues. Corporate authorities are responsible for paying the cost and fees for an attorney should one be needed to issue a final order for the corporate authorities to comply with and/or implement.
