**Fiscal Analysis**

The Senate amendments to the measure delete the language of the engrossed version and insert a section repealing [22 O.S. § 991a-21](#), which requires courts to impose a term of post-imprisonment supervision by the Department of Corrections.

Upon review and with consultation from the DOC, the Senate amendments to measure would result in significant cost savings to the agency. An exact amount is unknown at this time.
