Research Analysis

HB 1658 provides that upon the completion of a lethality assessment by a peace officer during a domestic violence investigation, the peace officer is to contact a local, certified domestic violence intervention program and communicate the responses given by the victim to the domestic violence intervention program provider. The peace officer is to encourage the victim to speak with the program provider for assistance and information regarding options and resources available to the victim.

Fiscal Analysis

HB 1658, as introduced, provides that peace officers completing a lethality assessment for victims of domestic violence crimes shall contact certified domestic violence intervention service providers and encourage victims to speak to service providers regarding options and resources available to the victim.

No need for additional state appropriated funding is anticipated for compliance with the provisions of the measure.
