HB1690 removes the requirement that the board of directors of a Federally Qualified Health Center be considered a public body and subject to the provisions of the Oklahoma Meeting Act.

The measure removes penalties and reporting requirements for non-compliance with the Oklahoma Open Meeting Act. The measure modifies the definition of “Public body.”
