**Fiscal Analysis**

The committee substitute to HB 1747 prohibits the Department of Corrections from utilizing the state supplemental payroll system. The measure requires all DOC employees to have their paychecks processed and issued through the state main payroll system.

Upon review and with consultation from the Office of Management and Enterprise Services and DOC, the measure could have a fiscal impact.

By prohibiting the use of the supplemental payroll system, the measure could lead to instances where DOC employees on a monthly payroll are overpaid. This would require DOC to collect the overpayment from employees, incurring potential costs to DOC. The ultimate impact of the measure is unknown.
