**Research Analysis**

The proposed Committee Substitute to HB 1757 modifies the time limitations for making arrests pursuant to a warrant by authorizing a misdemeanor arrest if the person is at any other place and is contacted by a law enforcement officer during the performance of his or her duties, provided that, the serving of the warrant is not the primary reason for contact with the defendant.
