## **Research Analysis**

HB 1758, as introduced, allows any corporation, business, or enterprise which is required to hold member meetings, board meetings, district meetings or annual meetings to permit members to attend and to conduct business virtually. The measure also removes language intended to allow virtual meetings due to the impact of COVID-19 on a temporary basis, ending November 15, 2020, or the state of emergency that was declared had terminated, whichever came first.
