**Research Analysis**

The Proposed Committee Substitute for HB 1789 allows local governmental units to create or contract with a purchasing cooperative in order to achieve best value or best terms in contracts. The measure allows any purchasing cooperative or interlocal cooperative to utilize a single legal newspaper of the state to meet its notice and publication requirements for statewide purchasing projects, and a newspaper within the boundaries of the cooperative to meet notice requirements for local or regional projects.
