Research Analysis

The Senate amendments to HB1801 strike the title, enacting clause, and language referring to priority enrollment at state universities, and inserts language updating the “Riley Boatwright Act” to “Riley’s Rule”.

The measure requires school boards, beginning 2021-2022, to coordinate with local emergency medical service (EMS) providers to develop an Emergency Action Plan for each school facility. The plan shall include:

- Maps and directions with appropriate contact information for emergency medical services
- Assign a medical administrator who is a current school employee
- Define responsibilities
- Include a list of medical equipment available
- Be posted in each facility
- Be distributed to all school officials involved in athletic activities

The Emergency Action Plan must be rehearsed annually with school officials and local EMS providers. Prior to any athletic event with visiting teams, the Plan shall be digitally transmitted to the school’s administrator or coach.
