## **Research Analysis**

HB1836, as introduced, requires the State Department of Education (SDE) to develop a system for coding teacher certification and renewal applications in order to report data on the pathways for teacher certification, including emergency certification.

The measure also creates a Data Governance Council, which is tasked with:

- Monitoring and evaluating the impact of each teacher certification pathway as reported by the SDE
- Identifying data elements indicative of teacher workforce quality
- Establishing best practices in data management

Qualifications for the council members are established in the bill.
