Research Analysis

The second proposed committee substitute for HB1836 requires the State Department of Education to develop a system for coding initial teacher certifications, including emergency certification, in order to report data on the pathways for initial teacher certification.

The measure also creates a Data Governance Council, which is tasked with:

- Monitoring and evaluating the impact of each teacher certification pathway as reported by the SDE
- Identifying data elements indicative of teacher workforce quality
- Establishing best practices in data management Qualifications for the council members are established in the bill.

The second PCS also modifies the composition of the council by adding the Secretary of Education and removing one member representing university-based educator preparation programs.
