Research Analysis

HB 1874 requires any private, nonprofit or for-profit organization which receives public funds from the state and provides philanthropic or humanitarian services to adults and children in developing countries to obtain consent for videography and photography before recording or photographing images of children and adults from or in developing countries. The measure requires that content be written in the language of the person providing consent, be revocable, be specific on how the images will be used and disseminated, state how the images will be stored and accessed, and consent cannot be required as a condition for receiving or obtaining services or assistance from the organization. The measure prohibits children and adults from being coerced or forced to participate in being recorded or photographed, being recorded or photographed in an unclothed way, or being recorded or photographed if they are in a dangerous situation or their health or physical safety is in jeopardy. The measure provides definitions.

Fiscal Analysis

HB 1874, as introduced, provides that any private, nonprofit or for-profit organization which receives public funds from the state and provides philanthropic or humanitarian services to adults and children from developing countries or who are living in developing countries shall obtain consent for videography and photography before recording or photographing images of children and adults from or in developing countries.
