**Research Analysis**

Senate Amendments to HB 1876 delete the effective date of November 1, 2021, and insert an emergency clause.

HB 1876 clarifies and extends an exception to the Oklahoma Open Records Act relating to public employee personal information. The home addresses, home telephone numbers, Social Security numbers, private email addresses and private mobile phone numbers of current and former public employees would not be open to public inspection or disclosure. Public records created using a private email address or private mobile phone would not be included within this exception.
