Research Analysis

HB 1896 creates the “Brain Death Standards Act.” The measure directs the Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision to declare certain rules. The measure requires the Board to consider standards and guidelines from certain entities and amend its rules when there are changes in certain standards and guidelines.

The measure prohibits declaration of brain death by certain persons and provides rules prohibiting potentially significant conflicts of interest. The measure allows for continuing medical education for physicians regarding the required standards governing determination of death.
