## **Research Analysis**

The proposed committee substitute for HB 1922 prohibits any express company, common carrier, or contract carrier, or any representative, agent or employee on their behalf, to knowingly deliver any shipping container that contains an alcoholic beverage unless it complies with the provisions and rules associated with the Direct Wine Shipper's Permit, nor shall any such entities knowingly deliver any shipping container that contains an alcoholic beverage to any person under the age of 21. The measure provides for fines for first, second, and third and subsequent offenses at not more than \$1,500, not more than \$2,500 and not more than \$5,000, respectively. Express companies, common carriers and contract carriers are held liable if their representatives, agents or employees violate these provisions.
