**Research Analysis**

HB 1944 allows CLEET to offer training that provides instruction for a peace officer on how to alert a school district or charter school about the presence of a minor child or a child who has reached 18 years of age and continues to be enrolled in high school if that child has been identified at the scene of a traumatic event or an event that involved a response from an emergency 911 service.
