Research Analysis

HB 1949 prohibits jails from using agency resources for immigration enforcement purposes. The measure prohibits the placement of peace officers under the supervision of federal agencies or to deputize peace officers as special federal officers. The measure prohibits the use of immigration authorities as interpreters for law enforcement matters. The measure prohibits the transfer of an individual to immigration authorities without a warrant or judicial probable cause determination. The measure prohibits dedicated office space within a county or municipal jail for immigration authorities. The measure prohibits the contracting with the federal government for use of Oklahoma law enforcement agency facilities to house federal detainees. The measure authorizes jails to perform certain immigration-related functions.
