**Research Analysis**

HB 1965, as introduced, removes the requirement that a county employee serve 5 years of full time employment with the county to qualify for a continuing education program. The measure authorizes the board of county commissioners to determine the years of service. The bill also allows the continuing education program to consist of courses offered by institutions outside the Oklahoma State System of Higher Education if approved by the county commissioners.
