**Research Analysis**

HB 1980 directs the Judicial Nominating Commission to promulgate rules to promote transparency in the Judicial Nominating Commission's selection process. The rules are to be prominently published on the Commission's website and must include publishing the results of a vote by the commissioners for a candidate, including any runoff votes, by displaying the total votes by the commissioners for the candidate on the Commission's website to be available for at least one year.
