**Research Analysis**

HB 1992, as introduced, allows the Office of Juvenile Affairs (OJA) to contract or operate group homes at the Southwest Oklahoma Juvenile Center campus. OJA may also contract with other states agencies to allow for children or young adults in state custody to reside and participate in any OJA related program or facility and with any tribal nation and/or federal agency or department in consultation with and approval by the Governor and the Oklahoma Attorney General.
