**Research Analysis**

HB 2011 declares that consent to adoption is not required if the court finds that the child was conceived as a result of rape perpetrated by the parent whose consent is the issue. Consent to adoption is also not required from a parent convicted of abuse, neglect, exploitation or sexual abuse of a child.
