## **Research Analysis**

The proposed Committee Substitute to HB 2034 declares that the oil and gas industry is a vital part of the economy and that the state and those companies that do business with the state should not boycott the oil and gas industry. The measure prohibits the state from entering into a contract with a company unless the company submits a written certification that the company is not currently engaged in a boycott of the oil and gas industry that constitutes an integral part of business conducted or sought to be conducted with the state. The is prohibited from adopting a procurement, investment or other policy that has the effect of inducing or requiring a person to boycott the oil and gas industry, or to boycott a person doing business with the oil and gas industry. The Oklahoma Secretary of State is to approve all contracts or may waive application on any contract with any state agency if the Secretary determines that compliance is not practicable. The measure provides definitions as used in the measure.
