**Research Analysis**

The floor substitute 2 to HB 2036 modifies a compliance deadline for vapor product reporting to the Oklahoma Beverage Laws Enforcement (ABLE) Commission from July 1, 2022, to July 1, 2023. The measure modifies the requirements for a vapor product manufacturer in submitting a Premarket Tobacco Product Application.

FA2 also modifies the date the ABLE Commission is required to publish a directory listing of all the manufacturers and vapor products listed in the report from October 1, 2022, to October 1, 2023. The measure declares an emergency.

**Fiscal Analysis**

The second floor amendment to the measure is a floor substitute. Major changes include moving the date of attestation submittal from July 1st, 2024 to July 1st, 2023. Clarification of the attestation contents with respect to federal Food and Drug Administration orders is provided.

The second floor amendment does not alter the fiscal impact of the committee substitute to the measure. Upon review and with consultation from the ABLE Commission, no direct fiscal impact to the state is anticipated from passage of the measure.
