**Research Analysis**

HB2049, as introduced, modifies the cost at which a conservancy district contract requires an advertisement for bids in a newspaper. The measure requires district contracts in excess of \$100,000 to be advertised. Formerly, contracts in excess of \$50,000 needed to be advertised.
