Research Analysis

HB 2088, as introduced, exempts the legislative and judicial branches of state government from fees and costs from services rendered by an executive agency.

Fiscal Analysis

HB 2088 in its current form exempts the Legislative and Judicial Branches of state government from fees and costs for services provided by appropriated state agencies. Legislative Branch entities expected to be impacted by the measure include the House of Representatives, the State Senate, and the Legislative Services Bureau. Judicial Branch entities expected to be impacted by the measure include the Supreme Court, the Court of Criminal Appeals, the Workers Compensation Court – Court of Existing Claims, the Workers Compensation Commission; and the District Courts.

Previous analysis of an identical measure during the 2020 session by officials from the Office of Management and Enterprise Services (OMES), concluded that based on anticipated rate models, an annual revenue loss to the Information Services Division (OMES-ISD) would result, as well as, corresponding savings to the Legislative and Judicial Branches. OMES estimates are as follows

OMES Revenue Loss	(\$450,253)
Legislative Branch Savings	\$40,346
Judicial Branch Savings	\$409,907
