**Research Analysis**

The proposed committee substitute for HB 2126 creates a grocery and convenience store spirits license. Licensees can purchase wine or spirits from a wine and spirits wholesaler and beer from a beer distributor or a small brewer self-distribution licensee, and sell such beverages for off-premises consumption only. Licensees may also sell spirits, wine and beer to charitable alcoholic beverage auction or event licensees. The measure sets a fee schedule for licenses and annual surcharges.
