Research Analysis

The committee substitute for HB 2135 modifies certain statutory provisions regarding financial interest to apply to the following, specifically licensed in Oklahoma:

- Manufacturers:
- Brewers;
- Wine and spirits wholesalers;
- Beer distributors; or
- Any employee, officer, director, stockholder owning 15 percent or more of the stock, any type of partner, manager, member or agent thereof.

The measure allows any out-of-state manufacturer or brewer who makes their products out of state to have an ownership interest in an Oklahoma retailer, so long as that retailer does not sell the products of the manufacturer or brewer.
