The Senate amendments to HB 2202 provides that no citation may be issued by any state, county, or municipal law enforcement officer during the 30-day period immediately succeeding the last day of the month during which a vehicle registration should have been renewed and a current license plate decal obtained and displayed on the license plate of the vehicle.

**Fiscal Analysis**

The motor vehicle registration and the issuance of title statutes currently provide the for all vehicles a penalty shall be assessed after the last day of the month following the expiration date, allowing for registration after expiration during the month following without penalty. Penalties are assessed after the allowable period.
