Research Analysis

The committee substitute for HB 2213 allows distiller licensees to sell their spirits for consumption on or off distillery premises and at public events. Products offered for sale by the distiller must have been sold and shipped to an Oklahoma-licensed wine and spirits wholesaler and then made available for purchase by the Oklahoma-licensed distiller.

Additionally, the measure allows wine and spirits wholesaler licensees to sell licensed distillers spirits that were manufactured by that distiller and that have been received and unloaded at a bonded warehouse facility of a wholesaler before such sale.

The measure has an emergency clause.
