Research Analysis

HB2213, as introduced, allows holders of a distillers licenses to sell their spirits for consumption on distillery premises or off-premises. License holders are also authorized to sell their spirits at public events.

Further, the measure allows holders of a wine and spirits wholesaler license to sell licensed distillers spirits that were manufactured by that distiller.

Fiscal Analysis

HB 2213, as introduced, provides that distiller license holders may sell spirits they produce for either on-premise or off-premise consumption.
