Research Analysis

HB 2233 authorizes a board of county commissioners to expend federal funds made available through the federal CARES Act or similar relief funds, regardless of any lack of specific state statutory authorization to perform the duties or functions for which the federal government has provided the funds. Receipt of CARES Act or similar funds would not be considered a supplemental appropriation and would not count as revenue when setting the county's budget for the next fiscal year.
