**Research Analysis**

The Proposed Committee Substitute for HB 2235 changes the appointment authority for the 7 members of the State Fire Marshal Commission. Three members would be appointed by the Governor, and two each by the Speaker of the House and President Pro Temp of the Senate. Terms would be four years, and each appointee would serve at the pleasure of their appointing authority. The measure also authorizes the Governor to select the chair of the commission from those appointees, and that chair would serve as the full-time State Fire Marshal.
