**Fiscal Analysis**

The proposed committee substitute to HB 2236 removes the requirement that law enforcement officers with the Workers' Compensation Fraud Investigation Unit have a minimum of three years of certified law enforcement experience. Instead, they must only be a certified peace officer.

The proposed committee substitute does not alter the fiscal analysis of the introduced version.
