**Research Analysis**

The Senate amendment to HB 2236 makes it a felony to fail to report to an employer, insurance carrier or third-party administrator any earned income while receiving temporary total disability benefits, rather than a “material change” in income.

**Fiscal Analysis**

The Senate amendments to the measure change the income reporting requirements from “a material change in” to “any earned”.

The Senate amendments to the measure do not alter the fiscal impact of the measure, which creates a felony and could potentially increase incarceration costs and fine revenues of the state.
