Research Analysis

HB 2240 directs the Information Services Division of the Office of Management and Enterprise Services to facilitate a needs assessment for a statewide interoperable radio communications system in consultation with the Oklahoma Office of Homeland Security, the Governor's Chief Information Officer, the Department of Public Safety and the Oklahoma Department of Emergency Management. OMES may hire a consultant to assist in the assessment and issue a report identifying the needs of users of the system, the operability of the system, budget estimates, funding options and governance recommendations by November 1, 2022. The measure also creates the "Statewide Interoperable Radio Communications System Fund".

Fiscal Analysis

HB 2240, as introduced, creates a new revolving fund for the Office of Management and Enterprise Services (OMES) designated the "Statewide Interoperable Radio Communications System Fund". The fund shall consist of all monies designated for deposit to said fund. The fund shall be used by OMES for the purpose of conducting a needs assessment for a statewide interoperable radio communications system.

The measure further directs the Information Services Division (ISD) of OMES to facilitate a needs assessment for a statewide interoperable radio communications system in consultation with relevant state officials.

The impact of the measure is under analysis with OMES and will be completed.
