**Research Analysis**

HB 2314, as introduced, adds definitions of “administrative information” and “area of concern” to Section 1025.1 of Title 56. The measure also states that an investigation must include a process for notifying a community services provider of areas of concern and administrative information, which are not final investigative findings. Further, the Department is required to develop a procedure by which a community services provider can request an investigative status update within ten (10) days of the investigation initiation.
