Research Analysis

The proposed committee substitute for HB 2316 modifies some of the duties for the 2-1-1 Oklahoma Coordinating Council, requiring them to develop and maintain national certification standards in compliance with the Alliance of Information and Referral Systems and stating that a duty is to provide recommendations to the Department of Human Services or state agencies for contracting and funding for services by 2-1-1 Oklahoma. The measure stipulates who should be on the 2-1-1 Oklahoma Coordinating Council and states that the Council is required to meet no less than two (2) times a year.

The Council is required to provide an annual report no later than July 30th of each year to the Department of Human Services and other states agencies who have contracts with qualified 2-1-1 service providers. The Department of Human Services and other state agencies may contract for 2-1-1 services statewide through contracts with qualified providers.
