## **Research Analysis**

The Senate amendment to HB 2316 renames the 2-1-1 Oklahoma Coordinating Council to the Oklahoma 2-1-1 Collaborative. The Oklahoma 2-1-1 Collaborative is designated as the state lead entity of all 2-1-1 call centers in the state. Duties include certifying information and referral providers who want to become 2-1-1 call centers, developing and maintaining certification standards in compliance with the Alliance for Information and Referral Systems, collaborating with entities as required under federal law or to receive federal funding, providing funding formula recommendations to the administering entity responsible for state and federal funds allocation, and submitting an annual report no later than September 1 of each year. The measure also provides that the membership of the Oklahoma 2-1-1 Collaborative shall be made of 15 members. Initial membership shall be selected by the current 2-1-1 call centers and vacancies shall be filled by the Collaborative. The Oklahoma 2-1-1 Collaborative shall meet no less than 2 times a year and they shall adopt bylaws governing their operations. Members shall serve without compensation or expense reimbursement. The state may comply with any requirements necessary to apply for and receive federal funding, if such funding becomes available.
